Overview

This qualification has a direct link to candidates seeking a traditional policing career and provides a useful step towards that goal. If it is achieved via an approved College of Policing Provider the achievement can be used as evidence towards the Policing Diploma, which is undertaken by all new recruits to the Police Service.

The qualification as has a considerably broader reach and should not be dismissed by candidates who have an interest in exploring other opportunities within the wider policing sector, where evidence gathering, conflict management, managing information, utilising legislative powers and other generic policing skills are required. These may include investigative and enforcement services within the private sector or areas such as Neighbourhood Management and Roads Policing a large contribution to which comes form from Local Government and other areas of the Public Sector such as the Highways Agency.

Learning Outcomes

To achieve the qualification the following mandatory units will be covered:

- Knowledge of evidence-based preventative policing
- Knowledge of supporting victims witnesses and vulnerable people
- Knowledge of managing conflict situations in policing
- Knowledge of using policing powers to deal with suspects
- Knowledge of conducting police searches
- Knowledge of handling information and intelligence
- Knowledge of providing an initial response to policing incidents
- Knowledge of conducting priority and volume investigations
- Knowledge of interviewing victims and witnesses in relation to priority and volume investigations
- Knowledge of interviewing suspects in relation to priority and volume investigations

You will work with an assessor to complete a portfolio of evidence that confirms you have met the requirements of the qualification.

There are no entry requirements or specific skills needed to undertake this qualification.
